

Great East Japan Earthquake Donation and Assistance

There are two ways in which you can donate for the disaster affected area. The easiest one is to donate through New Zealand Red Cross (see the following (2)) to Japanese Red Cross Society. Or you can donate directly to the Japanese Red Cross Society (see the following (3) bank account information). In the latter case, you may need to pay an extra charge to the bank and the donation is not tax-deductible. Also Japanese Society of Auckland who is working with the Japanese Red Cross Society is accepting donations. (See the following (1))
