Mr MINOYA Suguru joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan in 1987. At the Ministry's headquarters, he served in the Asian and Oceanian Affairs Bureau, the Economic Affairs Bureau, the Latin American and Caribbean Affairs Bureau, and the International Cooperation Bureau. Overseas, he was posted to the Consulate-General of Japan in Sydney, the Embassy of Japan in India, the Embassy of Japan in New Zealand, and the Consulate-General of Japan in Sri Lanka.

From 2017 to 2019, he served as Principal Deputy Director of the Foreign Nationals Affairs Division. From 2021 to 2023, he served as Senior Deputy Director of the South America Division, Latin American and Caribbean Affairs Bureau.

In addition, from 2015 to 2017, he served as Senior Director at the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), and from 2019 to 2021, he served as Secretary-General of the Foreign Press Center Japan.

From 2023 to 2026, he served as Deputy Consul General of Japan in Boston. In April 2026, he assumed his current position as Consul-General of Japan in Auckland.
